Its objective is to publish articles on current trends of research on Medical and Health Sciences, Life Sciences, Physical Sciences, Architecture and Spatial Sciences, Engineering, Social Sciences & Humanities, Law, Management, Defence Studies, and Computing etc.

Aim and scope

Focus of this journal is to encourage researchers to publish research papers in a multidisciplinary platform cutting cross boundaries in various disciplines.

Vision

Multidisciplinary studies for betterment of life.

Mission

Provide opportunities for researchers to share knowledge on critical issues on a multidisciplinary platform.

CRITERIA FOR PUBLICATION

The manuscript submitted for the journal should not be submitted in part or whole (except in the form of abstract) to any other journal for public or private circulation and no part of this manuscript should be copied from any other source. All authors are required to take the total responsibility for the content of the paper and are required to sign the author declaration template downloaded from the KJMS website (<http://lms.kdu.ac.lk/kjms/index.php>). The editorial board will make arrangements to check the originality of the contents of the manuscript using suitable plagiarism software. The contents of the manuscript should not be copyrighted, submitted, or published elsewhere (including the Internet), in any language, while the manuscript is under consideration for acceptance.

Authors have to confirm that any aspect of the work that has involved either experimental animals or human patients has been conducted with the ethical approval of all relevant bodies, and such approvals are acknowledged within the manuscript. If required the KJMS will seek the advice of **Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE - <http://www.publicationethics.org/>)** in order to handle cases of research and publication misconduct.

Authors are requested to go through the author guidelines published by the **KJMS** to prepare their manuscripts. Manuscripts should be about 4000 to 5000 words and should have an abstract with maximum of 300 words, keywords maximum of 6 separated by a comma, references, and discussion questions as well as any relevant tables, figures, and appendices.

With these guidelines authors shall use the live template downloadable from KJMS link <http://lms.kdu.ac.lk/kjms/index.php> to prepare the manuscript. This KJMS manuscript template is compatible with Microsoft Word 2007 or a later version. The authors can type over different sections on the active template or cut and paste from the prepared manuscript document and then use markup styles. Do not change the font sizes or line spacing to squeeze more text into a limited number of pages. Use italics for emphasis; do not underline or do not highlight in bold.

The manuscripts that fulfill the criteria of the journal will be checked for plagiarism with a standard software and sent to two referees with the required subject expertise decided by the editorial board for double blind peer review. Based on the comments and the recommendations of the two referees, the Editor -in- Chief with the consultation of the editorial board has the right to decide whether the paper should be accepted as it is for the current issue or kept in the waiting pool for the next issue, or resubmitted with revisions, or rejected. The decision of the Editorial Board will be conveyed to the corresponding author.

Submission of Manuscripts

In order to submit your manuscript to KJMS please do the following:

- (1) Prepare your manuscript according to the author guidelines
- (2) Format the manuscript in Microsoft Word and paste the contents to the live template using the headings given in the author guidelines document
- (3) Separate the title page and all author-identifying references.
- (4) E-mail before 31st December 2017 to the KJMS Editor-in-Chief at editorkjms@kdu.ac.lk
